Decision:- After deliberations, the Committee observed that the proposal is deficient in specific items details. Therefore, the Committee **deferred** the proposal of the Unit M/s. R K Flexo Printers Packers LLP for approval of inclusion of additional products in the LOA for trading activities without revision of projections for their SEZ unit located at M/s. Decision :- After deliberation, the Committee **approved** the proposal of M/s Siddhidhata Trading Co. for setting up of a Trading Activities at M/s. JNPA-SEZ in an area admeasuring 4358 sq.mtrs, at Plot No-F5 Sector 7, JNPA SEZ, envisaging FOB value of exports of Rs. 29.23 Crores, FE outgo of Rs. 18.41 Crores and NFE of Rs. 10.82 Crores over a period of 5 years with employment generation of 15 nos. (10 Men & 05 Women). Further, the Committee directed that separate areas to be earmarked with separate entry and exit for warehousing and trading activities for proper accounting and monitoring. The applicant was further directed to ensure all compliance like fire NOC, MPCB License, etc. before commencing operations. The Specified Officer was directed to draw samples of the material each time at the inbound and outbound stage and get it tested in government labs for confirmation of declaration of the goods.

JNPA-SEZ) as admeasuring an area 7858 sq. mtrs at Plot No-F5 Sector 7, JNPA SEZ, Developed by JNPA, Uran, Navi Mumbai – 400702 Out of which 3500 sq. mtrs for Warehousing activity and 4358 sq. mtrs for Trading activities as mentioned in their letter dated

These authorized operations will, however, continue to be subject to the various guidelines issued by Government from time to time. Approval Committees while approving goods and services for such default operation may look into the actual requirement of the SEZs for such operations."***

Instruction no. 54 dt. 30.04.2010 categorically states that ***as per the existing guidelines, no tax benefit can be extended to any construction activity outside the SEZ premises including water pipeline connection from the source to the SEZ.***

- The Developer in its letter dated 23.08.2023 has stated as under:

1. JNPA is developer Port Based Multi sector SEZ which is already operationalized.

2. In order to ensure stable water supply for the SEZ stakeholders as well as to JNPA Port users, a State Government Department of Water Supply i.e. Maharashtra Jeevan Pradhikaran (MJP) is engaged by JNPA to execute 40 MLD water supply scheme.

3. Out of total 40 MLD Water Supply distribution pipeline, nearly 15 MLD water is planned to be supplied to SEZ by laying 1118 mm diameter MS pipeline.

4. MJP has proposed the water supply pipeline partly inside SEZ to supply water to SEZ and then it goes outside SEZ to a Ground Service Reservoir (GSR) meant for supply water to Port Area.

5. Out of the total length of the pipeline nearly 3.17 km length of pipeline is proposed within the green belt of SEZ in Sectors 1, 2, 3 and 4.

6. This pipeline will be laid underground. The drawing showing the proposed alignment is enclosed.

Further, the developer has stated that –

- Neither MJP nor JNPA SEZ is claiming any sort of exemption for this proposed water supply pipeline even on the 3.17 Kms length which will pass through from SEZ notified boundaries.
- Since, this project is very crucial and important in order to ensure continuous

and stable water supply for SEZ users as well as port users.

- c. Also JNPA has no objection in MJP laying said pipeline through SEZ notified area as the same is meant for supply of water to SEZ users also.

Therefore, the Developer has requested to allow for laying pipeline for Water Supply to be laid completely underground within Green belt of SEZ notified area to the tune of approx. 3.17 Kms without availing of any duty/tax benefit. In the present case, the water supply pipeline is from MJP to JNPT Port through JNPA SEZ.
