(iv) Term/Tenure:

- 1. **SEZ Authority Members (non ex-officio):** Two years, not eligible for immediate re-nomination (as per SEZ Authority Rules, 2009).
- 2. **Board of Approval and UAC:** Continuing bodies with members serving as per their official designations; no fixed tenure.

(v) Powers and functions:

A. Board of Approval (BoA): As per Section 9(2) of the SEZ Act, 2005, the BoA is empowered to:

- 1. Grant, reject, or modify proposals for establishment of Special Economic Zones (SEZs).
- 2. Approve authorized operations to be carried out by developers in SEZs.
- **3.** Approve foreign collaborations and Foreign Direct Investment (FDI), including investment by persons resident outside India, for development, operation, and maintenance in SEZs (except where exempted by law or Government).
- **4.** Approve, reject, or modify proposals for infrastructure facilities in SEZs.
- **5.** Grant industrial licenses under the Industries (Development and Regulation) Act, 1951, for units proposed within SEZs.
- 6. Suspend Letters of Approval and appoint Administrators under Section 10(1) of the SEZ Act.
- 7. Dispose of appeals under Section 15(4) and Section 16(4) of the SEZ Act.
- **8.** Perform other functions as assigned by the Central Government.
- **B. Approval Committee (AC):**As per Section 14 of the SEZ Act, 2005 and Rule 17 of the SEZ Rules, 2006, the AC Committee is responsible for:
- 1. Approving proposals for setting up units within the SEZ.
- 2. Monitoring the performance and compliance of units with SEZ Act, Rules, and conditions of approval.
- 3. Granting extension of Letter of Approval and other operational approvals to units.
- **4.** Reviewing and deciding matters related to broad-banding, capacity expansion, merger/de-merger of units, change in constitution, etc.
- **5.** Taking action for violation of SEZ Rules and recommending cancellation of approvals where necessary.
- **6.** Considering applications related to debonding, exit from SEZ, and recommending proposals to the BoA where required.
- **C. SEZ Authority (as per SEZ Authority Rules, 2009):**Constituted under Section 31 of the SEZ Act, 2005, the SEZ Authority is responsible for:
- 1. Managing and developing the Zone efficiently and making it financially viable.

- 2. Preparing annual budgets, returns, and financial statements.
- **3.** Approving audited accounts and deciding remuneration for CA services.
- **4.** Planning for future expansion and undertaking capital works.
- 5. Implementing employee welfare schemes (limited to 5% of revenue).
- **6.** Approving expenditures including works, salaries, travel, legal, and professional expenses.
- 7. Allotting land/premises to approved units and executing lease agreements.
- **8.** Defending legal matters and protecting SEZ Authority's interests.
- 9. Maintaining land records and complying with Central Government directions.
- **10.** Writing off irrecoverable losses and entering into contracts with due approval.
- 11. Holding quarterly meetings and submitting annual reports to the Central Government.
