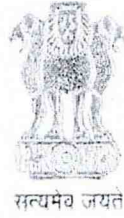

**Subject: Revised Guidelines for the National Award for the Empowerment of Persons with Disabilities.**

Empowerment of Person with Disabilities is an interdisciplinary process, covering various aspects namely, prevention, early detection, intervention, education, vocational training, rehabilitation and social integration etc. Section 24 of the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016 provides formulation of schemes and programmes to safeguard and promote the rights of persons with disabilities. Further, section 39 of the said Act mandates the Government to promote awareness campaigns and sensitization programmes inter alia for advance recognition of the skills, merits and abilities of persons with disabilities and of their contributions to the work force, labour market and professional fee.

Keeping in view the spirit of the above provisions of the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016, the Government intends to confer National Awards in recognition of contributions/skills of persons with disabilities individually or otherwise and also in recognition of the contribution made by Individual, the Government and the private bodies in the field of empowerment of persons with disabilities.

Now, therefore, with a view to give effect to the intention of the Government to confer such National Awards, the Central Government hereby prescribes guidelines for the National Awards for Empowerment of Persons with Disabilities, hereunder: -

**1 Description and categories of the awards.**

**I. National Awards for Individual Excellence**

## **2. Procedure for inviting applications for the awards and selection of Awardees:**

- (i) Applications to be submitted by eligible candidates or establishments or institutions in categories as prescribed in Para-1 above in the Rashtriya Puraskar Portal ([www.awards.gov.in](http://www.awards.gov.in)) of Ministry of Home Affairs, Govt. of India (after it becomes operational) in prescribed application form as at Annexure to these Guidelines. Applications may be submitted through self-nomination containing all relevant details specified in the format available on the above portal alongwith requisite documents and the applicant will be solely responsible for the authenticity of the documents submitted. The Department may verify the authenticity of the documents as and when considered necessary. Applications submitted online only be considered.
- (ii) Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment, Department of Empowerment of Persons with Disabilities (Divyangjan) shall intimate the opening of the National Awards Portal as well as the prescribed period for submission of applications through advertisement in the newspapers/web site of the Department.
- iii) A recipient of National Award for Empowerment of Divyangjan can apply for the National Award subsequently only after 5 years.

## **3. For short-listing of applications by Screening Committees**

- (i) There shall be Screening Committees for short listing of awardees in different categories of national awards. The Screening Committees shall comprise of four to five members, including the Chairperson, out of the following:
  - a. Serving or retired officers of the rank of Joint Secretary or above of the Central Government or Officers of the reputed Government Institutions;
  - b. Eminent personalities and experts in the field of disability or expert in the relevant field of award;
  - c. Representatives of Non-Governmental Organizations;
  - d. Officers of the rank of Deputy Secretary and above of the Department of Empowerment of Persons with Disabilities and organizations under the Department shall act as Convener of the Screening Committees.



(ii) The National Selection Committee shall decide the nomination of the awardees for various categories on the basis of recommendation of the Screening Committees.

(iii) The Chairpersons & Conveners of the Screening Committees shall assist the National Selection Committee in the selection process.

(iv) The non-official members of the National Selection Committee/Screening Committees shall be entitled to TA and DA in accordance with the financial rules and procedures as applicable in Government of India for eminent personalities nominated as non-official members in Committees/Boards/Panels.

(v) The awardees nominated under different categories of the national award shall be informed about date and venue of the national award function each year through Post/Telephone/Email. The awards may be received personally by the selected individuals or representative of the institution.

#### **4. National Selection Committee**

(a) The selection of the awardees shall be made on the basis of recommendations of the Screening Committees by a National Selection Committee.

(b) The National Selection Committee shall consist of the following :

- (c) The National Selection Committee referred to above may select higher number of awardees in any or all the categories or sub-categories referred to in the Table under Para-1.
- (d) The Department of Empowerment of Persons with Disabilities may co-opt members to the National Selection Committee.
- (e) The decision of the National Selection Committee shall be by a majority vote and in the extent of votes on both sides being equal, the Chairperson presiding over a particular meeting shall have a casting vote.
- (f) Selection Committee while selecting the awardees in the category give due representation to both rural and urban persons with disabilities and shall ensure equitable regional representation.
- (g) The decision of the National Selection Committee shall be final.

## 5. Criteria for selection.

### 5.1 For Category I - National Awards for Individual Excellence

- (A) (i) **Sarvshresth Divyangjan (Most Outstanding Divyangjan)** - There shall be 6 Awards (3 for male and 3 for female).

Open to all persons with disabilities having any of the 21 specified disabilities under the RPwD Act, 2016 and engaged in any field or activity i.e. Education/Health/Employment/ Art & Culture/Sports/Creative work/ Empowerment of Persons with Disabilities/Social service/ etc. who may exceptionally be a Role Model).

- (ii) **Shresth Divyangjan (Outstanding Divyangjan)** - There shall be 10 Awards with 2 Awards (1 for male and 1 for female) in each of the following categories:-
  - a. Locomotor Disability- (Locomotor, Muscular Dystrophy, Dwarfism, Acid Attack Victims, Leprosy Cured, Cerebral Palsy)
  - b. Visual Impairment-(Blindness, Low Vision)
  - c. Hearing Impairment - (Deaf, Hard of Hearing, Speech & Language disability)

- d. Intellectual Disability - (Mental Retardation, Mental Behavior, Specific Learning Disability, Autism Spectrum Disorder)
- e. Any specified disability except the disabilities mentioned from Sr. (a) to (d) above.

(Developmental Disorder, Disability caused due to Blood Disorder, Hemophilia, Thalassemia, Sickle Cell Diseases, Chronic Neurological Conditions, Multiple Sclerosis, Parkinson's Disease, Multiple Disability)

In the fields of employment/ self-employment, health/sports, art, culture, drawing, painting, music, or any other type of creative work, empowerment of PwDs etc.

However, if suitable person(s) in any one or more of the above sub-categories are not found, the awards may be given to additional person(s) in other sub-categories.

**iv) Divyangjano Ke Sashaktikaran Ke Liye Karyarat Sarvshresth Vyakti (Most Outstanding Person working for the empowerment of Persons the Disabilities)- One Award**

One National Award shall be given to individuals working for the cause of the persons with specified disabilities. Eminence of individual shall be determined on the following basis:-

The organization in which he/she works considers him/her as outstanding.

- a. He/she has been responsible for initiating new program or services in the last 10 years resulting in benefiting the people with disabilities particularly in rural areas.
- b. Paid officers of the Institution shall not be eligible for selection. However, paid workers/officers of the NGOs working for the cause of the disabled could be eligible.
- c. His/her contribution should be outstanding in the areas of disabled welfare/rehabilitation/education/training etc.
- d. His/her contribution in developing rehabilitation model for Community Based Rehabilitation and replicating the same in the inaccessible rural areas.
- e. Outstanding person championing the welfare and overall development of the disabled and sensitizing the community regarding rights and equal opportunities for the disabled.
- f. The quality of the work performed by the individual in the cause of the disabled and its significance for the cause shall also be given due weightage.
- g. He/she has outstanding professional achievements to his/her credit.

**v) Divyangata Ke Kshetra Mein Karyarat Sarvshresth Punarvas Peshewar/Personnel (Most Outstanding rehabilitation professional/personnel working in the field of disability) — One Award**

(One National Award shall be given to the best Rehabilitation Professional/Worker engaged in providing rehabilitation services or empowerment of persons with disabilities):-

**(vi) Divyangata Ke Kshetra Mein Sarvshresth Anusandhan/ Navpravartan /Utpad Vikas (Most Outstanding Research/Innovation/Product Development in the field of Disability) - One Award**

One National Award shall be given to the best research or technological innovation aimed at improving the life of persons with disabilities or the development of new cost-effective product for manufacture aimed at improving the life of persons with disabilities. The selection criteria for

- a. The innovative projects or technology shall be:
  - i. Development of an outstanding device, aid or adaptation which substantially improves the chances of the persons with disabilities in receiving education, obtaining or retaining employment and in being totally integrated in the socio-economic life of the community; and
  - ii. The effectiveness of the device in increasing the mobility, productivity and employment prospects of the persons with disability, maintainability of the device and its reparability.

Under the RPwD Act, 2016, State Governments /UT Administrations have been mandated to take forward programmes and policies for empowerment of persons with disabilities. The State Commissioner, Persons with Disabilities is accordingly take the steps:

- i. Identify, suo motu or otherwise, provision of any law or policy, programme and procedures, which are in consistent with the RPwD Act, and recommend necessary corrective steps
- ii. Inquire, suo motu or otherwise deprivation of rights of persons with disabilities and safeguards available to them in respect of matters for which the State Government is the appropriate Government and take up the matter with appropriate authorities for corrective action
- iii. Review the safeguards provided by or under the Act or any other law for the time being in force for the protection of rights of persons with disabilities and recommend measures for their effective implementation;
- iv. Review the factors that inhibit the enjoyment of rights of persons with disabilities and recommend appropriate remedial measures undertake and promote research in the field of the rights of persons with disabilities;
- v. Promote awareness of the rights of persons with disabilities and the safeguards available for their protection;
- vi. Monitor implementation of the provisions of this Act and schemes, programmes meant for persons with disabilities;



- vii. Monitor utilisation of funds disbursed by the State Government for the benefits of persons with disabilities; and perform such other functions as the State Government may assign.

In order to promote excellence and recognition of performance of a State Commissioner for Persons with Disabilities in achieving the mandated activities under the RPwD Act, 2016 in any State/UT, a National Award has been instituted for the purpose.

A National Award has been instituted with the objective of promoting disability, special education, research and thus creating a pool of rehabilitation professionals/personnel in the country and to promote excellence and recognize performance.

- ii. The boarding and lodging expenses of the awardees and one escort shall be borne by the Department of Empowerment of Persons with Disabilities, Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment.

- iii. To and fro travelling expenses and accommodation for up to one day prior and after the day of awards ceremony shall be arranged and the expenditure shall be reimbursed by the Department of Empowerment of Persons with Disabilities, Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment.
- iv. Being eminent personalities, the TA/DA admissibility of the awardees and their escorts shall be equivalent to a Class-I officer of the Central Government in pay level 14 (pre-revised Grade pay Rs.10,000/- in the Pay Matrix in terms of para-1(III) of Department of Expenditure, Ministry of Finance, Govt. of India O.M. No.19047/1/2016-E.IV dated 14.9.2017 as amended from time to time.
